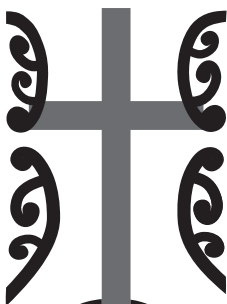


## ***Ka tipu tahi i roto i te Atua***

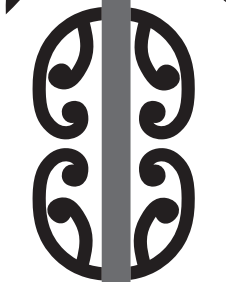
Growing together, becoming one in Christ

Ngā hau e whā***



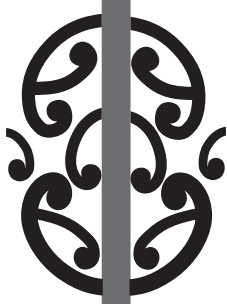
The Fern Fronds are used to symbolise the four winds. We come together from different parts of the world.
