Director's Corner

Greetings everyone - as this will be the last FYI for Term 1, we reflect over the last 7 weeks and realise 'we've only just begun'. Please note the following start and finish times:

**Term 1** - ends Wednesday, 4 April due to a Bible Workers' Seminar at LAC. Accommodation is in girls' dorm.

**Term 2** - dorms open Sunday 22 April and finish date is Friday 29 June. Both dormitories will then be used over the July holidays as accommodation for the Junior Boys Indoor Cricket Championships in Palmerston North.

**Term 3** - dorms open 15 July and ends Friday 28 September. Term 4 dorms open 14 October, with finishing times varying due to NCEA exams for Year 11, 12 and 13. A reminder that year 13 grad weekend is 2 and 3 November.

### 5 Weekly Reviews

This year the college has added "5 Weekly Reviews" to its monitoring of student achievement. Every five weeks teachers report to the year level deans on students who are failing to keep with their work or are unfocused. The deans then contact parents where there is a pattern of this behaviour.

Some of you will already have been contacted and we value your support in keeping our students on track. If you have heard nothing, this signals that teachers believe your student is on task and the work is getting done.


