<b>General Activity Donation</b>	This covers everything that is not paid for by the Ministry of Education. This is paid directly to the college and used to fund college activities, as currently our funding from the Ministry of Education does not fully cover these. The college is extremely grateful that most parents choose to pay this donation. Tax deductible if the parent/caregiver is a NZ resident who pays tax.	<b>\$230 /year</b>  The third and subsequent children are half price
<b>Special Character Donation†</b>	This annual fee is also paid to the Proprietor, NZ SDA Schools Association, to fund the Bible curriculum in Seventh-day Adventist Schools. It is invoiced but not compulsory. With multiple children attending LAC, the fee is charged on a pro-rata basis.	1st child = <b>\$100</b> 2nd child = <b>\$75</b> 3rd child = <b>\$50</b> 4th child = <b>\$25</b>

## Chargeable & Collectable Fees

<b>Attendance Dues*</b>	This is a compulsory charge that is paid to the Proprietor (NZ Seventh-day Adventist Schools Association) to maintain College property. Payment is a legal requirement of the Ministry of Education.	<b>\$550 (7-8) /year</b> <b>\$790 (9-13) /year</b>
<b>Camp Fee</b>	Camps are provided for Years 7, 8, 9 and 13. Payment is compulsory for Years 7, 8, 9 and 13. *Where students go on camps and class trips, a charge may be made to cover the actual cost of these trips. Teachers will advise you in writing when these are to occur and the costs involved.	<b>\$200*</b> /year (Yr 7, 8 & 10) <b>\$300*</b> (Yr 13)
<b>Student ID Card</b>	All students receive an ID card at the beginning of the school year.	<b>\$10 /year</b>
<b>Practical Material Cost</b>	Particular subjects that include a 'take home' component such as woodwork, incur additional charges. For a list of these subjects and their associated charges see the 'Subject Selection Sheet'.	<b>\$120 /year</b> (Yr7-9) Cost will vary (Yr 10-13)
<b>NCEA Fee</b>	It is compulsory for all students in Years 11-13 to pay the New Zealand Government NCEA fee. This payment is required as all students complete credits that are registered with the Ministry of Education.	<b>\$76.70 /year</b> (NZ\$ or equivalent)
<b>Leavers' Banquet</b>	This banquet occurs in August each year for Years 12 and 13 only. <i>If a student does not attend, their account is credited</i>	<b>\$80 /year</b>
<b>Extra Music Lessons</b>	Students can choose to have individual lessons with itinerant music teachers on a variety of instruments. Students must commit to the lessons on a term-by-term basis. If a student drops out during the term, the fee will not be reimbursed.	Costs will vary
<b>Printing Fee</b>	Every student starts with \$20 printing credit at the beginning of the school year (cost: Black & white <b>4c</b> /page; Colour <b>40c</b> /page).	<b>\$20 /year</b>



# LAC House Boarding Fees

Boarders are housed in two dormitory buildings on the Longburn Adventist College Campus. The girls' and boys' dormitories accommodate students in double (shared) and single rooms. The cafeteria, which includes a fully equipped industrial kitchen, is located in a separate building within walking distance of the dormitories. Within the cafeteria building, is the dining room and multipurpose/lounge area.

Other student facilities for the Longburn Adventist College boarders include a tennis court, basketball court, athletics ground, and access to the LAC gym and music suite. There is a covered area for storage of bicycles.

<b>Uniform Fee</b>	This is an estimated base rate to cover uniform cost. Additional items over the value of \$500 will incur an extra cost.  Second hand uniforms are available from LAC Reception.	<b>\$600</b> /year
<b>Accommodation Fee</b>	Room, electricity, water, laundry, amenities and supplies, and facility maintenance, 24-hour Boarding Dean care and study supervision.	<b>\$6,300</b> /year (\$157.50 /wk)
<b>Meals Fee</b>	Boarders are provided with an abundant supply of well-balanced vegetarian food. The catering team is able to provide for different dietary requirements and boarders are able to request meal options.	<b>\$5,650</b> /year (\$141.25 /wk \$6.73 /meal)
<b>Activities Fee</b> incl. transportation costs	Boarding includes a range of activities during the week and on weekends. Activities may be in-house boarding events or be connected with the school or local church.  Some activities may have extra charges. Examples of such activities are ski trips and international service trips.	<b>\$200</b> /year (\$5 /week)
<b>Room Maintenance Fee</b>	No room deposit required. The fee covers general maintenance in the dormitories e.g. door handles, mirrors, lights and other minor repairs.	<b>\$210</b> /year
<b>Local Travel Fee</b> <i>Not including International Airport pickup/drop offs</i>	This fee covers travel to medical appointments, Thursday & Sunday shopping trips, small group and individual appointments, local bus / train / airport travel arrangements, local sporting events and competitions.	<b>\$500</b> /year (\$125 /term)

*Payment Options: Boarders' fees require an up-front \$1,000 deposit. The remainder may be paid up-front or by instalments.*
