1. Complete the **MYERS BRIGGS** <http://www.16personalities.com/free-personality-test> and;
2. **VARC** <http://vark-learn.com/the-vark-questionnaire/> (copy and paste results into your word document)
3. Find out your NSN and IRD numbers.
4. Find out your parent/guardian mobile number and email address.
5. Have you Drivers License or passport number available also.
6. Know what subjects you take.
7. Write 400-500 words (this is not long) about why you want to attend COACH and what you think the benefits will be for you by attending.

WAP will be visiting schools in your region and booking a visit to meet with all rangatahi interested in applying to COACH.
