ESOL Programme Fee	For ESOL tuition (English for Speakers of Other Languages), exam fees and associated activities	\$4,250 /year
General Activity	This is a compulsory charge that is paid to the Proprietor (NZ SDA Schools Association Ltd) to maintain College property. Payment is a legal requirement of the Ministry of Education. Fee includes \$20 printing credit and \$10 for Student ID.	\$260 /year The third and subsequent children are half price
NCEA Fee	It is compulsory for all students in Years 11–13 to pay the New Zealand Government NCEA fee. This payment is required as all students complete credits that are registered with the Ministry of Education.	\$383.30 /year for Y11-13 only
Attendance Dues & ISPMML*	This is a compulsory charge that is paid to the Proprietor (NZ Seventh-day Adventist Schools Association) as owners of the College facilities. Payment is a legal requirement of the Ministry of Education.	\$1,140 /year for Years 7-8 \$1,1580 /year for Years 9-13
Special Fee	A compulsory charge that covers additional costs such as the Ministry of Education levy.	\$1,000 /year

Payment Options: Caregivers may pay up-front or by Termly instalments to be able to apply for a student visa:
