The purpose of this email has three parts;

- 1. to give an update after today's government COVID announcement;
- to communicate that the NZQA Examinations will be starting two weeks later;
- 3. to clarify the impact of the change to NZQA external examinations on the school calendar for the remainder of 2021.

Today's Government COVID Announcement - Friday 27 August 2021

The government announced today that areas south of Auckland will move to Alert Level 3 on Tuesday, 31st August at 11.59pm. Up until this time we will remain in Alert Level 4.

What does Alert Level 3, from Wednesday 1st September, mean for LAC?

- Online learning for all students will continue and teachers will remain at home.
- The current timetable will remain the same (periods 1-4).
- Essential workers may send their children (Year 7-10 only) to LAC. Students will complete online learning under the care of the Senior Leadership team.
- Buses will not be operating and the dropping off and picking up of students is the responsibility of the parent/caregiver.
- If you wish your child to attend school in Alert Level 3, please email Rosalind Burnett (dp@lac.school.nz) by Monday, 30th August.

In short the only significant change will be for children of essential workers who wish to bring their children to school. It is when we move to Alert Level 2 when the majority of students will return to LAC.

There will be an additional government announcement on Monday 6th September. When that happens, we will communicate with parents, caregivers and students, and update the next steps forward.

NZQA external examinations starting two weeks later

Yesterday the government announced that the NZQA External examinations will be delayed and start two weeks later on Monday 22 November. Originally it was Monday 8 November. To check the dates and times of individual subjects, use the link below.

I want to apologise in advance as I know some of the changes will impact on your plans, particularly Graduation weekend. Please appreciate we have not made these changes lightly but at the same time our community needs certainty. Some dates, such as the Maori/Pasifika Hui have yet to be confirmed.

12th November (Fri) Last day Year 13

15th November (Mon) Y11/12 Prizegiving and Final day for Year 11/12

22nd November (Mon) **NZQA exams start** (refer to NZQA website for specific subject dates and times)

14th December (Tue) last day NZQA exams

14th December (Tue) Y7-10 Prizegiving and last day of school for Year 7-10
