International Boarding Fees Summary

Boarders are housed in two dormitory buildings on the Longburn Adventist College Campus

The girls' and boys' dormitories accommodate students in double (shared) and single rooms. The cafeteria, which includes a fully equipped industrial kitchen, is located in a separate building within walking distance of the dormitories. Within the cafeteria building, is the dining room and multipurpose/lounge area.

Other student facilities for the Longburn Adventist College boarders include a tennis court, basketball court, athletics ground, and access to the LAC gym and music suite. There is a covered area for storage of bicycles.
